Join us Wednesday evening for a presentation on St. Brother Andre Bessette, CSC the famed builder of St. Joseph's Oratory in Montreal. His major relic will be here to be venerated after a short talk on his life, a period of Eucharistic adoration and Mass. Blessing and veneration of the relic is possible after Mass as is blessing with St. Joseph's oil.


Upon the death of the Pontiff, the Church begins an official period of nine days of mourning known as the Novendiales. Cardinal Farrell, the Camerlengo (the person responsible for running the day to day business of the Church when the See of Rome is vacant), decreed that the days of mourning would begin on Saturday, April 26 – the day of Pope Francis' funeral. Because the Easter Octave is so important, masses for the dead were unable to be celebrated. Our parish will celebrate a Memorial Mass of the Dead for the soul of Pope Francis on Thursday, May 1, at 7 p.m.

After several demonstrations of celebrating Mass *ad orientem*, that is with priest and people facing the same direction in anticipation of the second coming of Christ, all masses will be celebrated in this way at Sacred Heart Church moving forward. I see it as part of our overall parish renewal in that it will assist us to concentrate more on what Mass is about rather than on what the priest is doing or who the priest is. I realise that not everyone is going to like this; however, it is my experience that it has had positive effect at St. Joseph's Church for the past several years.

A reminder that a men's group meets every Thursday evening in St. Joseph's hall at 7 pm. All men of the parish are welcome to attend for some spiritual discussion, prayer and social time.

A Mass to pray for the upcoming conclave will be celebrated for that intention on Saturday, May 3 at 8 a.m. at St. Joseph's Church. Everyone is encouraged to attend, as well as to begin praying earnestly, perhaps with fasting, for this important moment in the Church. May the Holy Spirit guide the Cardinal Electors in choosing the next Pontiff.
